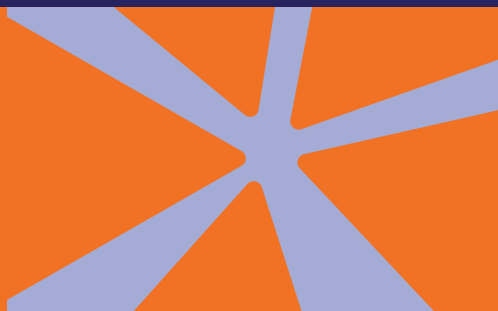

GAME OF FORMS



NEMO COLLECTION is a mosaic-like game of forms based on trapezoids and triangles. The core idea of scaling and combining these basic forms gives Nemo its unique character. By combining different elements it is possible to create new forms and let the organism grow to meet even larger scale functional needs. Rhythm and variation is created by height alternatives.

The possibility to use different colours in upholstery, also partly in the same element, gives architects and interior designers endless chances to create unique solutions. Elements can be stable or movable by adjusting them with foot knobs or castors with brakes.

STRONG BASE AND ELEGANT DETAILS

Elegant upholstery details give Nemo sitting modules their characteristic appearance but their function is also to preserve the monolithic beauty during the years of use. Upholstery materials can be chosen among the most common textile manufacturers collections. Material can be fabric, leather, vinyl according to interior requirements.

In each Nemo sitting module there is comfortable fire-proof foam on top of a strong veneer construction. Upholstery is always done with care. Different forms and sizes make one, two or several people fit to sit, and by combining elements a whole group.



COMBINING IS LIKE PLAYING

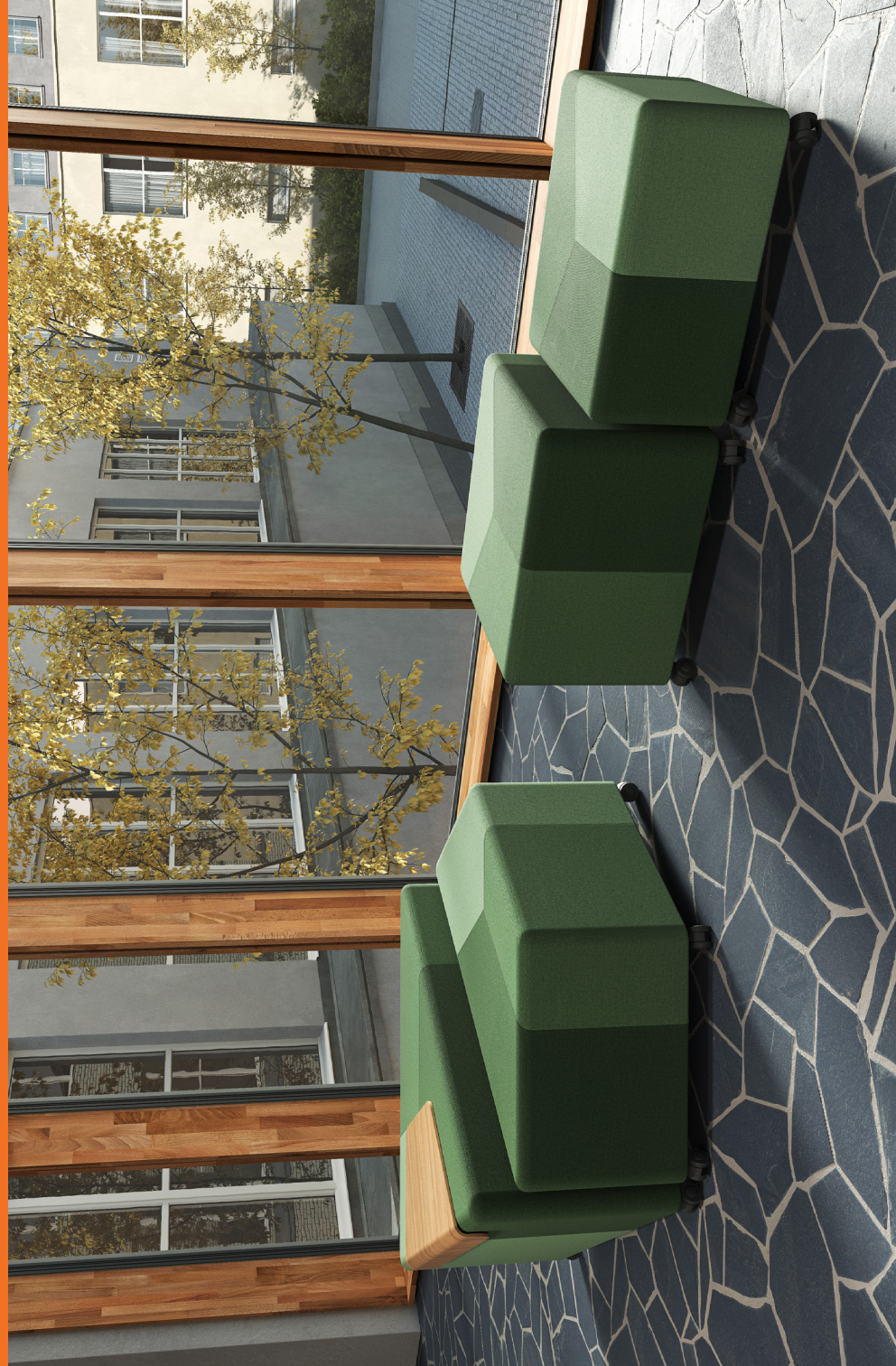
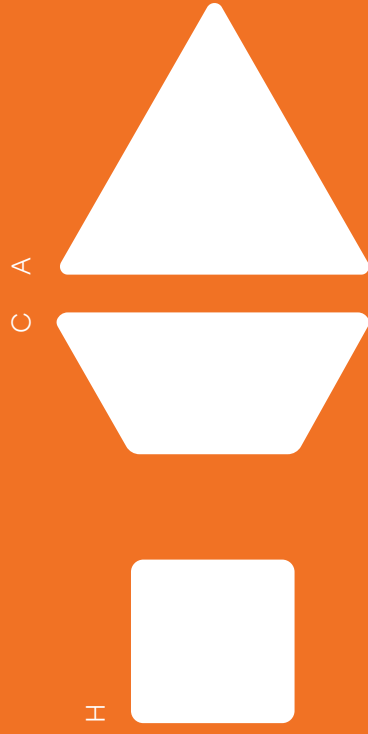
Like sitting modules also desks are designed with same principle. Trapezoid and triangle based forms create desks for one, two or several users. Nemo desks fit exceptionally well in today's co-working or educational environments. Due to smoothly running castors the smaller ones are easy to move and the forms meet each other without caps. Bigger models have totally different dynamics compared to normal rectangular tables, which makes them more democratic and especially suitable for creative working.

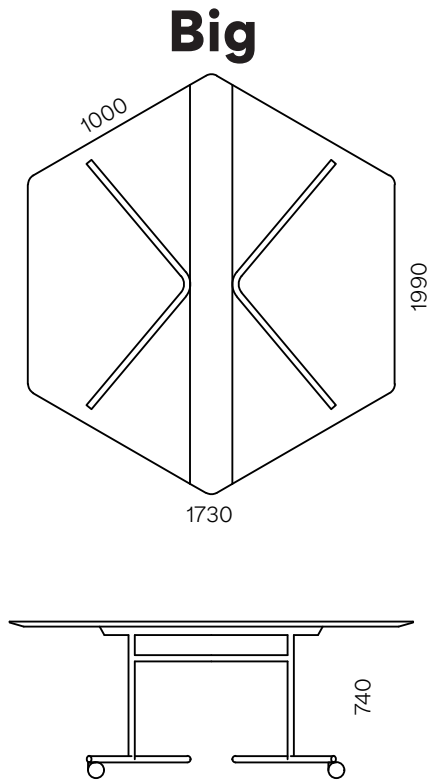




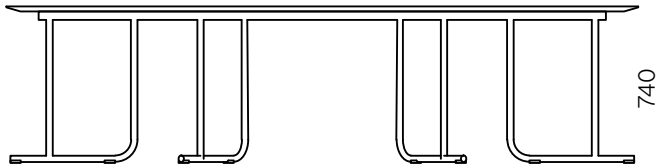
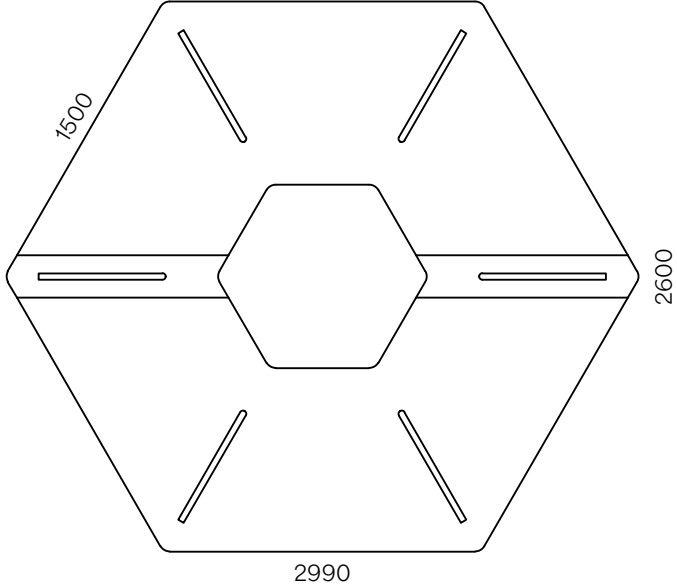








Monster
